# 9. Cnoc Buidhe (Belltown Power)

A constructive meeting had taken place with the executive team @ Belltown to discuss terms available to extend CSO beyond the 1+4% terms tabled (if this development was to be eventually granted consent by A&BC/Scottish Government). An NDA was signed-off between the parties and an MoU agreed between the parties that will require consultation with the Community Councils invited by the developer to participate in their offer of shared ownership.

An application for CARES support to advance negotiations with Belltown had been uploaded to the CARES portal.

### 11. Communications & Marketing

### Marketing

Regular updates to the Kintyre Wind website had been completed. Additional ammendments to align with the recent amendment/approval of the refreshed model rules were 80% complete. Action ongoing.

### **Engagement Strategy**

Following the latest tabling of The 'Share the Wind' petition (PE1885/C) promoting mandatory community shared ownership in Scottish windfarms via land tax reform by the Scottish Governments' Citizen Participation and Public Petition Committee, the petitioner had responded to the Committee's feedback by the SNIB and Environment Minister. #### Communications

JB had chased the civil servants with whom EKREG were liaising with a view to receiving an update on their progress with changing government policy on community ownership. As yet no response had been received.

A date for the next ACT-led Working Group meeting had been received. It was agreed that AB would participate (given JB is unavailable on the date set) to represent Kintyre Wind interests - the main item on the agenda will be the establishment of the working Group's remit, role and objectives.
